EVENT RULES

1. All house rules of Baylinks® Golf posted in the bays must be observed.
2. (a) (Team League) Players will be identified as either the #1 player or the #2 player of the team. The #1 player will be the player with the lower handicap of the two. Each player will play against the player on the other team with the corresponding number. Six points will be at stake each night on a net basis as follows:
 - 1 point for the winner of match play by #1 players
 - 1 point for the winner of match play by #2 players
 - 1 point for the winner of stroke play by #1 players
 - 1 point for the winner of stroke play by #2 players
 - 1 point for the winner of team match play
 - 1 point for the winner of team stroke play
2. (b) Individual League Player v. Field point system based on net scores.
3. The honor code of golf with respect to play and scoring shall apply. Play your best. No mulligans. All OB's and hazards shall be played as "Drop" ("drop the ball, add one penalty stroke," which the computer will score automatically). If the ball hits the side curtains, the pad above the screen, the mesh netting, or the ceiling and does not result in a stroke on the computer, the player must add that stroke to his or her final computer score before reporting it.
4. Play shall be from the white tees for men and from the red tees for women.
5. A ball with a lie in the rough or in a bunker must be dropped from a distance of approximately 6 inches onto the rough or bunker panels. Rough and bunker panels may be reversed for lob shots out of the rough.
6. Putting shall be set at 6 foot "gimmies" and 3-putt maximums.
7. If a player on a team is unable to play on a certain date, he or she may play the scheduled round before that date. Substitutes are allowed with handicap, provided they have a GHIN or have played a handicapping round; otherwise, at zero handicap.
8. The Commissioner shall establish initial handicaps for the League and on a weekly basis make any necessary mathematical adjustments to those handicaps. A maximum number of handicap strokes may apply. The Commissioner shall also establish the schedule and maintain the standings. It is the responsibility of all participants to report their scores and results to Baylinks® Golf at the conclusion of their round by signing and turning in the paper scorecard.
9. All decisions by Baylinks® Golf with respect to the administration of the League are final.
10. These rules are subject to change upon notice.
